

MAINTAINING A SAFE CAMPUS ENVIRONMENT

FACULTY AND STAFF PROTOCOLS IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

IF YOU RECEIVED A BOOSTER

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 5 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

OR

Or tested positive for Covid-19 within the previous 90 days



Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days. You do not need to quarantine.



At least 5 days after your close contact, secure PCR test* and submit it to the Coronavirus Campus Liaison**.



If you test positive, stay home and contact the Coronavirus Campus Liaison for guidance.

IF YOU ARE NOT VACCINATED ARE NOT BOOSTED

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than 5 months ago

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine more than 2 months ago



Stay home for 5 days



For an additional 5 days, wear a well-fitting mask around others. If you cannot wear a mask for the additional 5 days, quarantine for those 5 days.



At least 5 days after your close contact, secure an external PCR test* after the quarantine is satisfied and submit it to the Coronavirus Campus Liaison**.

FACULTY AND STAFF PROTOCOLS IF YOU HAVE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR IF YOU HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT

IF YOU HAVE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS



Isolate and do not come to class or attend social events.



Contact the Coronavirus Campus Liaison* who will conduct the contact tracing.



If symptoms persist, get tested with an at-home, rapid-antigen, or PCR test administered at a non-CUNY site.**



If your test is negative, you may return to work in person when you feel well enough to do so.

IF YOU HAVE A POSITIVE RESULT FROM AN AT-HOME, RAPID-ANTIGEN, OR PCR TEST



Isolate for 6 days from the date of the test result—even if you are vaccinated. Do not come to work or attend social events. Wear a well-fitting mask if you are around others in your home.



If You Had Symptoms



End quarantine after 6 full days if you are fever-free for 24 hours



If You Did Not Have Symptoms



End quarantine after 6 full days



Secure an antigen or PCR test from an external testing site*. If it is negative, you can return to campus.^

^In lieu of a **negative PCR test**, you may present a letter from your health care provider that clears you to return to in-person classes.
